Patients with upcoming dental appointments should not take non-steroidal Anti-inflammatory drugs (NSAIDS) for five days prior to their procedure.

This is a list of most common list of NSAIDS to avoid. This is not an all-inclusive list. Tylenol is the only over the counter pain reliever that should be taken prior to appointments.

- Advil -Ibuprofen
- Aleve-Naproxen
- Aspirin
- Celebrex
- Ibuprofen
- Midol- Ibuprofen, Naproxen
- Motrin-Ibuprofen
- Naprosyn
- Naproxen
- Toradol

*Please also avoid – vitamins or supplements

- Fish oil, Krill oil
- Ginseng
- Gingko
- Ginger
- Garlic
- Green Coffee or Tea

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
